SAMPLE BEQUEST LANGUAGE

PERCENTAGE OF ESTATE FOR UNRESTRICTED PURPOSES

I give, devise, and bequeath to the Interchurch Food Pantry of Johnson County Endowment Fund at the Johnson County Community Foundation (JCCF), a nonprofit organization located in Franklin, Indiana, or its successor in interest, ____% and the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate."

I instruct that all my charitable gifts shall be made, to the extent possible, from property that constitutes "income in respect of a decedent" as that term is defined in the Internal Revenue Code.

SPECIFIC AMOUNT FOR UNRESTRICTED PURPOSES

I give, devise, and bequeath to the Interchurch Food Pantry of Johnson County Endowment Fund at the Johnson County Community Foundation (JCCF), a nonprofit organization located in Franklin, Indiana, or its successor in interest, \$_____ and the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate."
